together was very unique. One day we all went into Lima to buy what we call a "start up kit" for a feeding center. The kit consists of pots, bowls, spoons, a washtub, a 30 gallon can for water (there is no running water where our new feeding centers are). We also purchased a stove, not like the ones in the USA. This propane stove, has two burners and 4 legs as a stand. The kit was for the new feeding center in La Gorila but God had other plans for this new stove.

I was in Peru with Brian and Stevie in September. We met

up with Hector and our time



The next day Hector and I delivered the stove to the Puente Piedra Feeding Center, early in the morning before the workers arrived. We took it around back where they feed the children breakfast. When the ladies who volunteer to cook for the feeding center were told we were there, they were excited and came around back to see

us. When they saw the stove, they began to cry! Over a stove? We then found out, that the day before they were praying about having a stove and talking about how they might possibly get one. It would help them prepare the meals four times a week for about 60 children each time. Cooking on wood took a lot of extra time each morning. That stove, which was purchased for only \$75 was a huge blessing and a big answer to prayer.



Hector and I were just messengers delivering God's blessing on behalf of the people in the USA who responded to the FATHERS call to help the widows and orphans, to feed the hungry and to cloth the naked. This is truly a sweet smelling aroma to God the Father.
