## FIELD REPORT: AN ANSWER TO PRAYER in PISCO, PERU

Before we arrived in Pisco, Pastor Carlos, told Hector about Javier and Rosa and the home they had been living in for 10 years. He sent us a picture (top left) which inspired us to immediately say "yes" to building a new home for them.

We arrived on the site, Mike, Mary, Hector and I, were greeted with wide smiles and broad hugs from Javier, Rosa and grand daughter Sayuri. Once the prefab house arrived and we started building, you could see the excitement on their faces about their new little home. They would finally have windows, a concrete floor, a real roof and their own bedroom! Javier shared with us that he had always wanted to give his wife something better than the little home he had constructed from straw, bamboo, tarp material etc. This new home was a big answer to prayer!

When we completed the house, I walked through their new home with them, looking at the gleam in their eyes and asking them which room would be theirs. They said they hadn't decided yet, but the thought they would have their own room was such a blessing to them. It was evident, how much they loved each other and their precious grand daughter, Sayuri. Before we left, we snapped a final picture in front of the home and hugged them as we said our good byes. As we left, I thought about how blessed we were to be a part of God's answer to Javier's prayer to meet the needs of his family. God is magnificent!

A few weeks after we arrived home, we received really sad news from Hector that Javier had died. You can imagine how stunned I was at the news. At first I thought, "God why would you allow this to happen?" Then I realized, God knew it was Javier's time to go to his heavenly home and was making sure Rosa and Sayuri had a decent home to live in once he was gone. He sent us to answer Javier's prayer but also to care for a soon to be widow and grand daughter. Our Heavenly Father knows best!

Please pray for Rosa and Sayuri, we will be visiting them on our February trip to see how they are doing and to see what we can do to help as they adjust to life without Javier.
